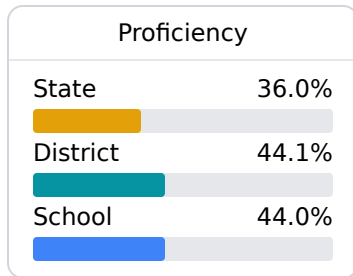
### School Accountability Grade Components

Mississippi's accountability system assigns "A" through "F" letter grades for schools and districts. Grades are based on student achievement, student growth, student participation in testing, and other academic measures.

These disruptions may have influenced a student's opportunity to learn, motivation and/or assessment administration conditions. Results presented should not be considered comparable to prior years. 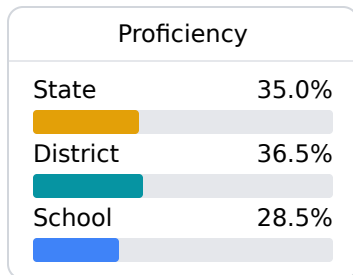

Measurements of student performance on the statewide math assessment.



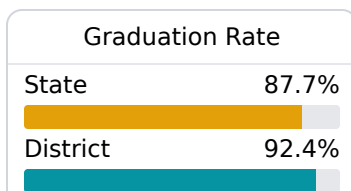
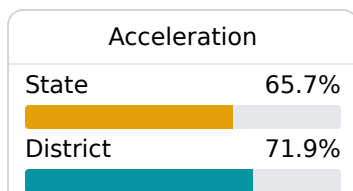
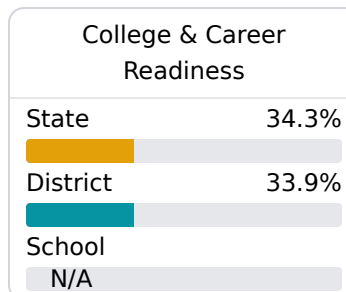
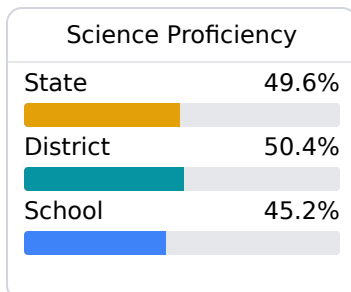
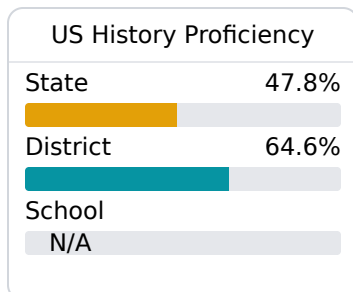

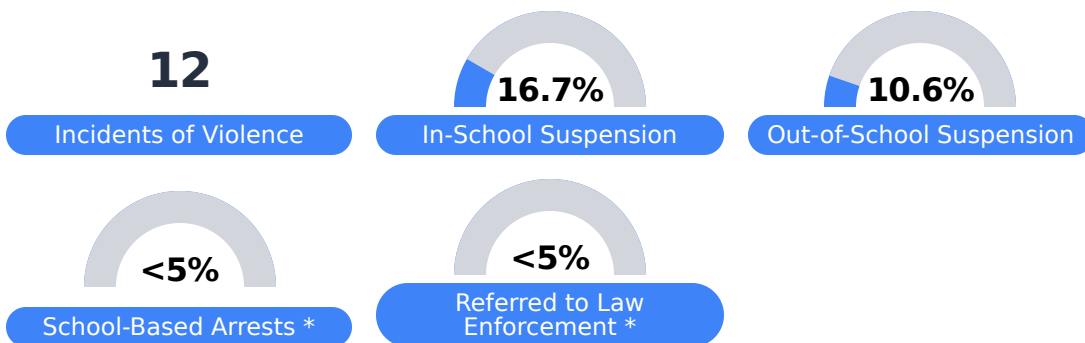
